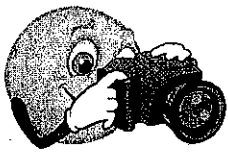


2017-18
Kindergarten Registration

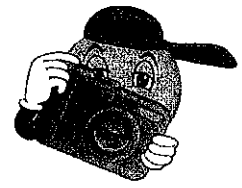

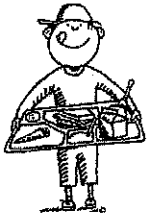


**Amberly's Spring Picture Day
Wednesday, March 22nd!**

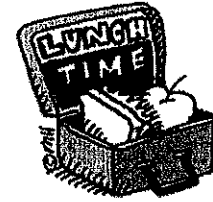
